

MYG Netball Tournament Rules

General Rules

- All general MYG rules apply, including deadline procedure
- The tournament will be played to England Netball High Fives rules
- Duration of the games will depend on number of entrants, but will be no less than five minutes and no longer than eight minutes, with a two minute half time to change bibs etc)

Squad Rules

- Squads shall consist of a minimum of seven players and a maximum of nine players (Maximum of 3 Boys in a squad)
- Teams shall consist of five players, three girls and two boys on court at all times
- Substitutions are allowed at half time
- All players during every match must rotate positions after every half played, during the two minutes half time

Equipment Rules

- Size 4 Netballs will be provided for the tournament
- Each team must provide their own set of bibs

Playing Rules

- All players must play in three of the different playing areas throughout the period of the tournament. Areas are shooting, defending and centre
- Obey the footwork rule
- One jump to intercept the throw or shot is permitted provided that the player is at least 1 metre away and that the arms are not outstretched prior to the throw. Jumping up and down in front of a player is not permitted
- A player must pass or shoot within four seconds
