





Passport to Leisure

Application form and information guide

The discounted access scheme for:

- Registered unemployed
- Adult social care recipients
 - Senior citizens
- Income support recipients
 - Job seekers
- People claiming incapacity benefit or employment and support allowance



What is Passport to Leisure?

Passport to Leisure is a discount card that makes sport and leisure more accessible to a wider group of people who live in Medway. It gives them and their dependants reduced prices or free access to some facilities in Medway at certain times.

Who qualifies for a Passport to Leisure?

To qualify for a Medway Passport to Leisure you must fall into one of the categories listed below and live in Medway.

You may be eligible if you are:	What documents you need to provide:

Receiving Income Support	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Two passport style photographs• Proof of your identity• Income Support award letter

Please note: One-to-one tuition is not included. No Passport to Leisure cards will be issued without documentary proof.

How much does a Passport to Leisure cost?

A registration fee of £2 per person is charged for a one-year pass (April to March). A fee of £2 will be charged to replace lost cards. If you lose your card you will need to provide another photograph.

Discounts

Your discounts will include:

- reduced fees and charges on a range of specified activities at Medway Council-provided sport and leisure facilities;
- reduced fees at other venues, such as Jumpers Rebound Centre.

Discounts do not apply to:

- group or team games (unless all participants are Passport to Leisure holders);
- block bookings;
- activities other than those specified at each venue.

Please note: Passport to Leisure customers will need to show their Passport to Leisure card in order to claim scheme benefits and discounts.

Venues taking part in the scheme

The following sports providers are supporting the Passport to Leisure scheme by offering discounts to cardholders. Purchases should be for the cardholder only. Passport to Leisure cards should be shown before buying goods or services and all discounts are at the discretion of the manager or proprietor.

Medway Park

- Free use of the pool: Monday, Wednesday and Friday, 1-3pm, Saturday and Sunday, 10am-12noon.
- £3 use of the gym: Monday, Wednesday and Friday, 1-3pm, Saturday and Sunday, 10am-12noon.
An induction fee of £8.50 will apply.
- Free use of badminton and squash courts: Monday, Wednesday and Friday, 1-3pm.
(Subject to availability and courts cannot be pre-booked. Non Passport to Leisure customers will be required to pay 50% of the court cost plus admission. Hire fees for equipment apply and Passport to Leisure cards must be left as deposit).

- Free use of the pool: Monday to Friday, 2-4pm during the summer season. No weekend concessions.

Splashes Sports Centre

- Free use of the pool: Monday, Wednesday and Friday 9-11am. Tuesday and Thursday, 12noon-3pm **school term-time only**. Saturday and Sunday: 12noon-2pm reduced fee applies.
- £3 use of the gym: Monday, Wednesday and Friday, 9-11am. Tuesday and Thursday, 12noon-3pm.
No weekend concessions.
(An induction fee of £8.50 will apply. Users must show both Passport to Leisure pass and gym user's card to gain entry).

Hoo Sports Centre

- Free swimming: Monday to Friday, 1.30-3.30pm **school term-time only**. Saturday and Sunday family splash session, 11am-1pm. Reduced fees apply.
- £3 use of the gym: Monday to Friday, 1.30-3.30pm.
(An induction fee of £8.50 will apply. Users must show both Passport to Leisure pass and gym user's card to gain entry).

Strood Sport Centre

Watling Street, Strood - 01634 333933

(Phone the centre to check the activity programme).

- Free use of the sporting facilities Monday to Friday, 1.30-3.30pm.
- £3 use of the gym: Monday to Friday, 1.30-3.30pm.
(An induction fee of £8.50 will apply. Users must show both Passport to Leisure pass and gym user's card to gain entry).

Passport holders may not have free-of-charge use at any organised session or club activities. Subject to availability and facilities such as courts cannot be pre-booked.

Looked after children

Children in council care, foster care or where the council is acting as their guardian can now use the Passport to Leisure scheme enabling free use during any public session. However, to apply for your card you must contact Medway Council Children's Services direct on 01634 335660, instead of filling out the form.

Gym use is still payable and under 16-years-olds will still need to go to the supervised sessions. Older looked-after children (16+) can use the Passport to Leisure scheme during any public session time.

All other Passport to Leisure conditions still apply, for example not being able to book activities in advance.

Conditions of use

1. Passport to Leisure is not transferable and must carry a photograph of the holder.
2. Valid only when shown on arrival at any participating facilities.
3. If the holder no longer qualifies for Passport to Leisure, the card must be returned to an issuing centre, together with any issued to dependants.
4. Cardholders are subject to any terms and conditions applicable to the places where the card is being used.
5. The facility management involved in the scheme reserves the right to refuse entry if the passport is abused in any way. This will lead to the withdrawal of the Passport to Leisure card.
6. From time to time, to ensure that the Passport to Leisure is not being abused, we reserve the right to check eligibility.
7. Expired cards must be returned when applying for a new Passport to Leisure card.
8. Cardholders must live in Medway and any change of address must be notified to an issuing centre.
9. The council reserves the right to alter these conditions.
10. Replacement cards are available at a cost of £2 each.
