

LOCAL AUTHORITY BUS SUBSIDY RING-FENCED (REVENUE) GRANT DETERMINATION 2017/18

The Minister of State for Transport (“the Minister of State”), in exercise of the powers conferred by section 31 of the Local Government Act 2003, makes the following determination:

Citation

1) This determination may be cited as the Local Authority Bus Subsidy Ring-Fenced (Revenue) Grant Determination (2017/18).

Purpose of the grant

2) The purpose of the grant is to provide support to local authorities in England towards expenditure lawfully incurred or to be incurred by them.

Determination

3) The Minister of State determines as the authorities to which grant is to be paid and the amount of grant to be paid, the authorities and the amounts set out in Annex B.


Grant conditions

4) Pursuant to section 31(3) and 31(4) of the Local Government Act 2003, the Minister of State determines that the grant will be paid subject to the conditions in Annex A.

Treasury consent

5) Before making this determination in relation to local authorities in England, the Minister of State obtained the consent of the Treasury.

GRANT CONDITIONS

1. Grant paid to a local authority under this determination may be used only for the purposes of supporting bus services (including community transport services run under a section 19 permit), or for the provision of infrastructure supporting such services in that authority's, or a neighbouring authority's, area.

2. The Chief Executive and Chief Internal Auditor of each of the recipient authorities are required to sign and return to the team leader of the BSOG team^[1] in the Department for Transport a declaration, to be received no later than 30 September 2018, in the following terms:

“To the best of our knowledge and belief, and having carried out appropriate investigations and checks, in our opinion, in all significant respects, the conditions attached to Local Authority Bus Subsidy Ring-Fenced (Revenue) Grant Determination 2017/18 have been complied with”.

3. Local authorities are required to report on how they have made use of the devolved funds and any decision making processes that followed. This should be done annually (by completing and submitting a short survey that will be issued by the Department) and this information should be published on their website (with a web link to this material being supplied to DfT).

4. If an authority fails to comply with any of the conditions and requirements of paragraphs 1, 2 and 3, the Minister may -
 - a. reduce, suspend or withhold grant; or
 - b. by notification in writing to the authority, require the repayment of the whole or any part of the grant.

5. Any sum notified by the Minister under paragraph 4b. shall immediately become repayable to the Minister.
