corners and junctions causing obstructions.

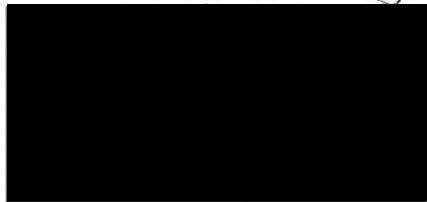
It is impossible to get doctors appointments, I recently waited four weeks just to see a nurse.
