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HOMES FOR UKRAINE

We fully support the Government's approach and tenants who wish to help those affected and will help where we can. Just a few things to remember in relation to complying with your tenancy agreement with Medway Council should you wish to register via the Government's website.

If you're thinking about supporting a family, please be aware

- You will need to seek written permission from the council.
- We will need to check that your home will not become overcrowded.
- You will need to provide the council with the names of who is staying with you.

- You must continue to pay your rent and any arrears.
- You must not move out of your home and let someone else live there without you.
- You must be able to offer a room for at least 6 months.
- You will be responsible for the behaviour of anyone in your home.
- The Government has advised that there will be an optional £350 a month "Thank you" payment for as long as you sponsor a family. This will be paid in arrears. This payment should not affect any benefit entitlement or Council Tax Single Persons Discount.

E-CIGARETTE MYTH BUSTING

Are e-cigarettes regulated?

E-cigarettes are regulated under the Tobacco and Related Products Regulations 2016 and must meet minimum standards of quality and safety.

E-cigarettes contain nicotine, are they harmful?

Nicotine is the reason people become addicted to smoking. However, evidence shows that nicotine causes minimal risk of harm to health. It is the thousands of other chemicals in tobacco smoke that cause the most harm to health. E-cigarette vapour does not contain tar or carbon monoxide which are the most harmful elements in tobacco smoke. E-cigarettes are not risk free but are far less harmful than cigarettes. Is exposure to e-cigarette vapour harmful to bystanders?

Current evidence has found no identified health risks of passive vaping to the health of bystanders. The vapour does contain some chemicals also found in tobacco smoke, but at much lower levels!
