Secondary Schools Road Safety Education

Your Journey to School - Year 7

Students refresh their road safety knowledge, working through tasks to identify safer places to cross, the green cross code and identifying potential hazards on their daily journeys.

Lessons are delivered by the Road Safety team via TEAMS, lasting for approximately 55 minutes.

Speak Up - KS3

In this lesson students will discuss the importance of speaking up in potentially dangerous situations. This is a teacher led resource.

Emergency Stop - KS3

Students will confront assumptions about road safety and the impact of distractions on reaction times. This is a teacher resource.

Campaign HQ - KS4

Students will be encouraged to think about how the consequences of a crash might affect them, a friend or a family member in their day-to-day lives. Teacher led resource.

Dangerous Habits - KS4

An opportunity for young people to reflect on their behaviours, as a pedestrian or a passenger. Teacher led resource.

Young Driver & Passenger Course - Yr 12 & 13

A four part course, which is supplied through a Vimeo link.
