Keystone Centre Refurbishment Briefing

Refurbishment work will take place at the Keystone Centre, Gun Lane, Strood, to improve and modernise the clinical treatment rooms and increase the capacity to offer more clinics at the centre.

The works will begin on 26 November 2012 and be undertaken in two phases.

Phase one is the development of office space for staff who currently use designated clinical rooms as offices, which limits the number of clinic sessions available at this site. This phase is planned to start at the end of November 2012.

Phase two will increase the number of clinical rooms at the centre, improve the layout and provide a higher standard of decoration and equipment. Phase two is planned to start mid-December 2012 for completion on 1 March 2013. During this period, interim arrangements have been made for the clinics currently held in the area being refurbished to be held elsewhere in Medway – the alternative clinic arrangements are shown in the table overleaf.

A communications plan has been developed to ensure that a broad range of stakeholders, including patients, staff, GPs, pharmacies, Medway Council, service providers and service referrers, are advised of the interim arrangements. A briefing will also be sent to the local media.

All of the clinics temporarily interrupted are attended by appointment only and patients will be notified by staff of the alternative clinic arrangements when making their appointment. The exception to this is the Hi Kent hearing aid clinic, which is a walk-in clinic and will continue to be held at Keystone during the works period.

Clinics held in the areas not being refurbished will not be interrupted and will continue to be provided at the Keystone centre during this time.

Throughout the refurbishment, we would like to reassure you that patients will continue to have the same level of access to their clinic appointments.
